Guidance notes

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE arrive on site with your wrist bands on, it speeds up entry and prevents queues backing on to the road. It is also most important to wear your wrist band throughout the event so we know that you are part of the club and not someone looking for a free bike! It will also help us at the Saturday evening meal.

Campers, would you please pitch your tents a few feet apart so your guy lines don't cross and form a trip hazard between tents, a particular problem during the hours of darkness. If you plan to have your own BBQ **PLEASE DO NOT** have it on or over the lawns, there are plenty of stone surfaces around the site for you to rest them on. Make sure you remove all your tent pegs so you don't damage the trusts lawn mowers during the following weeks.

Due to the AMCT introduction of the Air B&B in the Hall they will have the Eagle gate (the one nearest to the Hall) permanently open which causes us a problem of an unsecured entrance to the estate. As a result we strongly advise ALL members to **bring a lock and use it**, we hope there will be a facility to lock the bikes inside overnight courtesy of the Moulton Bicycle Company alternatively leave them in your car.

On Friday evening we were hoping to get a mobile catering van, however we have been unable to secure one meaning you will have to source your own meal on Friday evening (in town, takeaway, delivered...) campers you may wish to bring a little more food. The marquee will be available for meeting and drinking as there are very few large pubs left in town.

Quiet and well behaved dogs are welcome in the Hall grounds but it is the owners responsibility to clean up the inevitable mess.

The club are always on the look out for good items to raffle, if you wish to donate items please hand them to a committee member during Saturday morning.

The Saturday afternoon rides are to Great Chalfield Manor, a medieval country house & gardens, normally closed on Saturday but they have opened up especially for us. We have 2 rides, the longer ride, 11 miles, leaves at 2pm and the shorter ride, 5 miles, leaves at 2:30pm both expected to arrive at about 3pm. For those unable to ride please come in your car so we can all share the experience, free parking is available along the grass verge outside the Manor gates. SatNav postcode SN12 8NH Tea/coffee & biscuits £3 or tea/coffee & cake £5, kindly partake to repay their generosity and feel free to make a donation to the Manor.

No dogs, other than assistance dogs are permitted in the grounds.

We plan to depart at around 4:30 riding the 3.5 miles back to the factory.

And finally, if you want a drink on Friday &/or Saturday evening in our marquee you will have to provide your own, whether that's water, carbonates, beer, cider, wine, cocktails etc. and don't forget to bring a glass for your drinks, if you want one!

We are obtaining some canned "Moulton Bicycle Club" beer from the Kettlesmith brewery and also bottles of wine which will be available to purchase during the evenings.
